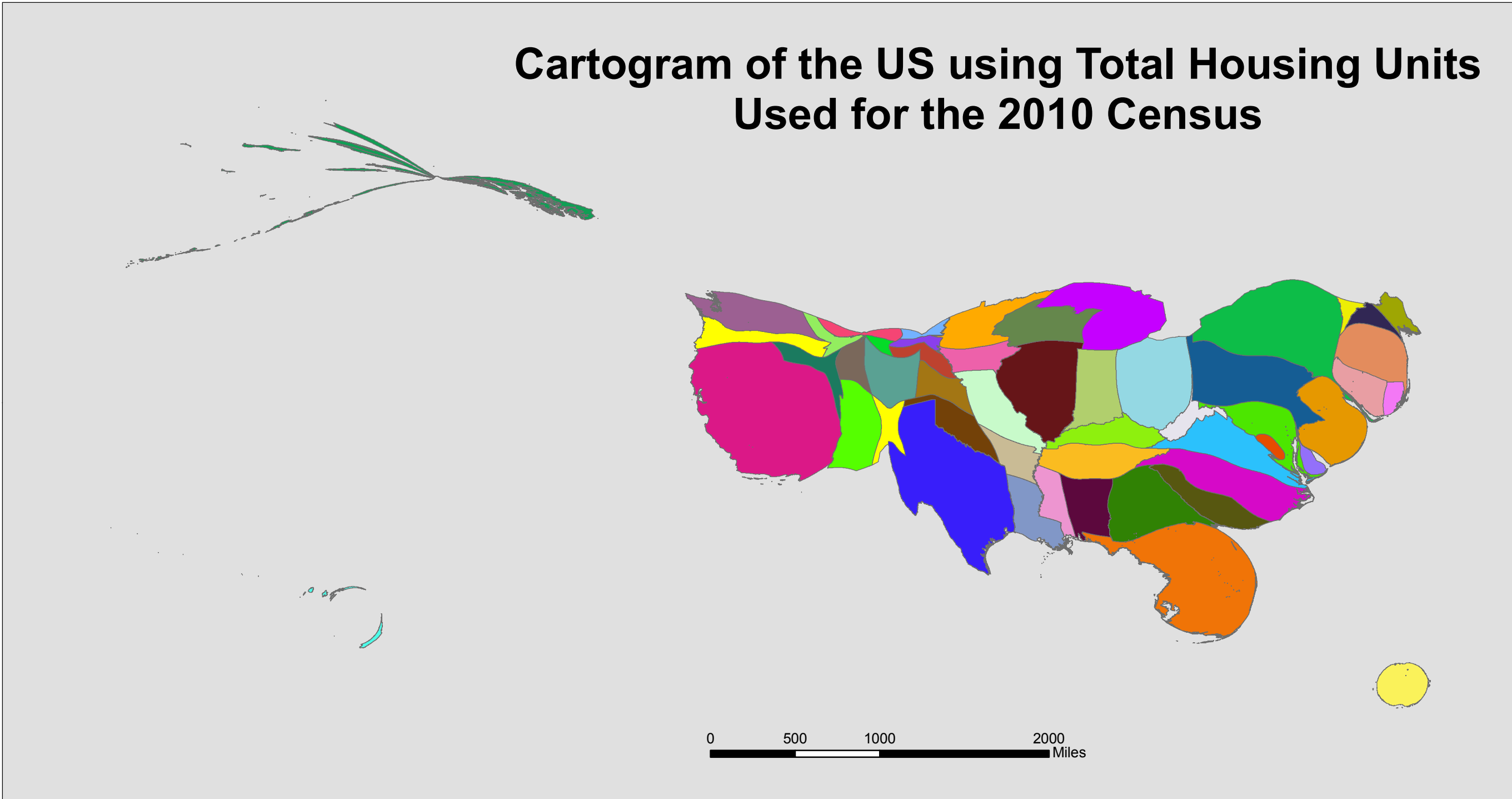


Cartogram of the US using Total Housing Units Used for the 2010 Census

A cartogram is a map in which some thematic mapping variable such as Housing Units is substituted for land area. The geometry or space of the map is distorted in order to convey the information of this alternate variable. This Housing Units cartogram is a value-by-area map, which illustrates the relative sizes of the populations scaling the area of each state in proportion to its number of housing units. The shape and relative location of each state is retained as much an extent as possible, but inevitably a large amount of distortion occurs.
